

## **Delhi Process VI: Delhi Process VI: Exploring New Development Paradigms and Growth Strategies**

New Delhi, 28 August 2022

GDC-RIS organized a two-day programme on “Towards Indian G20 Presidency: Exploring New Development Paradigms and Growth Strategies- Partnerships in Times of Transition and Contestations” on 27-28 August 2022.

On this occasion, the keynote address was delivered by India’s G20 Sherpa Mr. Amitabh Kant.

Session 1 on New Development Paradigm and Principles of Cooperation highlighted the key themes of the New Development Paradigm, Global Development Initiatives and Scope for Partnership and Cooperation, Going beyond Modalities of SSC, NSC and TrC, Development Banks and Resource Mobilisation. It covered the deliberations on the key differentials of development strategies being adopted by EU, US, G-7 and China, namely – Blue Dot Network, Indo-Pacific Economic Framework, Global Gateway Initiatives of EU, Partnership for Global Infrastructure and Investment by G-7; Global Development Initiative and Belt and Road Initiative of China.

Session 2 deliberated on Global Governance and Agenda 2030 with key themes on Adaptation at and for Multilateral Institutions and Global Governance; Macroeconomic Challenges and Weakening Means of Implementation (Finance & Technology); Declining enthusiasm for leveraging multilateral institutions, and the need for recalibration towards SDGs 2.0.

Session 3 on Development Pathways and New Measurement Approaches focused on the key themes of Sustainable Consumption and Production and Beyond GDP – Measuring Development and Wellbeing. It highlighted the statistical and data issues of developing countries and the need to revamp census data, and strengthening of national statistics system, which consists of extensive social dimensions parameters.
